 4. Come ye wea - ry, hea - vy la - den, Bruised and mangled by the fall; If you tar - ry till you're bet - ter, You will ne - ver come at all.

B. 5. View him groveling in the gar - den, Lo! your Maker prostrate lies! On the bloody tree be - hold him: Hear him cry, be - fore he dies:

 4. Not the righteous, Not the righteous, Not the righteous; Sin - ners Je - sus came \_\_\_\_\_ to \_\_\_\_\_ call.
