The melody (*Tenor*) is the basis for the three-part version in William Walker's *Southern Harmony*, 1835, called *Restoration*. Walker used different words, from John Newton's hymn, *Mercy, O thou Son of David*.

William Walker wrote a fourth part (Alto) for his arrangement in 1876.

William Walker's version was re-arranged by T. B. Newton and S. W. Everett for the 1911 edition of *The Sacred Harp*, p. 312; they returned to the words from Robinson's hymn.
