## Editorial Comment:

These two four-part settings are No. 25 and 26 in the collection: *Sacrorum Hymnorum Liber Primus Centum & triginta quator Hymnos continens, ex optimis quibusq[ue] Autoribus collectus, inter quos primiartifices in hac æditione sunt, Thomas Stoltzer, Henricus Finck, Arnoldus de Bruck. Et alij quidam Vitebergæ apud Georgium Rhav Anno 1542.*

The setting of the first stanza is explicitly attributed to Stoltzer in the collection but the setting of the seventh stanza is not ascribed to any composer.

Only stanzas 1 and 7 of the Hymn (from the Vespers of Annunciation) are printed in the collection. Stanzas 2 - 6 used in this edition on the plainchant setting based on Stoltzers Tenor are supplied from other sources. Stoltzers Tenor-melody is similar all-though not identical with the roman version of the chant.
