Detailed description: This system contains measures 67, 68, and 69. The Soprano part (S) begins with a half note G4, followed by quarter notes A4, B4, and C5. A slur covers measures 68 and 69, which contain a sixteenth-note triplet (D5, E5, F5) and a sixteenth-note triplet (G5, A5, B5). The Bass/Contralto part (BC) consists of a single bass line with a half note G3 in measure 67, a half note F3 in measure 68, and a half note E3 in measure 69.
