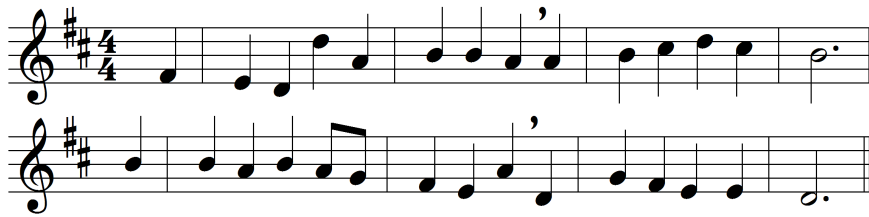


Jesu, our hope, our heart's desire AMNS 86
